Inside tourism : reasons for travel

People travel for many different reasons. In the tourism industry we divide the reasons for travel into three main categories: leisure tourism, business tourism and visiting friends and relatives (VFR). Leisure tourism can mean anything from excursions, day trips and weekend breaks to package holidays, pleasure cruises and longer independent trips such as hill-walking or treks in the mountains. It also includes cultural trips (for example to music festivals), educational trips (study tours) and religious trips (pilgrims on a walking tour to a holy place). Business tourism includes any travel away from one's main place of residences, for such events as meetings, conferences and trade fairs. It also includes special trips when workers are given a reward or a 'thank you' for good work. Travel in order to visit friends or family relatives is also regarded as part of the tourism industry. This could be for a special family party, such as a reunion or a wedding, or a regular trip made every year.
